

# MOSED, A MAN OF DESTINY

## God Prepares a Delivered

Exodus 1,2

### I. GOD'S PEOPLE GREATLY BLESSED

*Proverbs 10:22* **The blessing of the LORD**, it maketh rich,  
and he addeth no sorrow with it.

**A. God sends a deliverer to His people during a great famine**

1. Thirteen years of bondage and at age 30 he becomes the

second most powerful man in Egypt **(Gen**

**41:41-44,46)**

2. Joseph is sent by God to deliver His people

**Gen 45:5** *Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life.* (also **Gen. 45:7-10**)

**Gen 50:20** *But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive.* (**Gen. 37:5-10** *Dream of sheaves & Sun, Moon and Stars*)

**B. God gives His people the best land**

1. Pharaoh gives God's People the best land **(Gen. 45:16-18)**

2. Joseph places God's people in the best land **(Gen. 47:11)**

**(the city Rameses is in the Goshen area of Egypt)**

**C. God blesses the families of His people (Exodus 1:7)**

### II. GOD'S PEOPLE GREATLY OPPRESSED

**A. Sometimes things get worse before they get better**

1. A new king arises that brings about slavery **(Exodus 1:8-11)**

2. God has a plan and no one can stop it **(Exodus 1:12)**

**B. God is the God of every circumstance no matter how difficult**

1. God has promised to be with us at all times (*Heb. 13:5*)
2. God has promised to supply for all of our true needs (*Ph. 4:19*)

**C. God uses great adversity to teach us great lessons**

1. We are strangers in this land (*Gen. 15:13, Heb. 11:8-16*)
2. God uses adversity to build strong people (*Prov. 24:10*)
3. Sin always brings the need for deliverance (*Matt. 6:13*)
